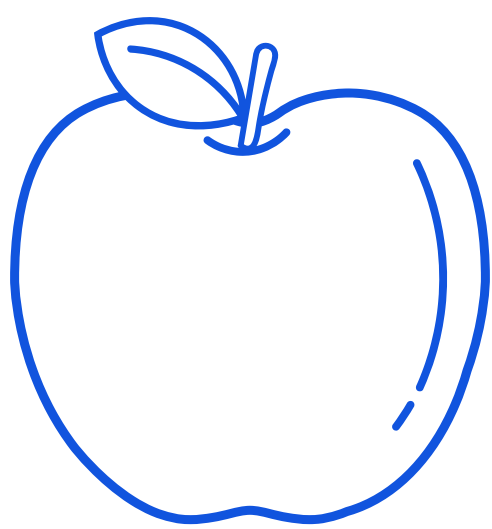


5 Creative Real-World Student Motivation Classroom Examples

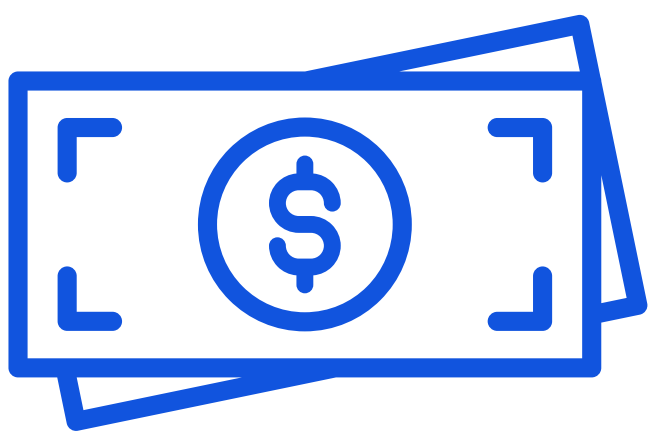
"Lunch Bunch" with the Teacher

Try reading stories to your class out loud. Encourage your students to complete tasks for a chance for more classroom reading.

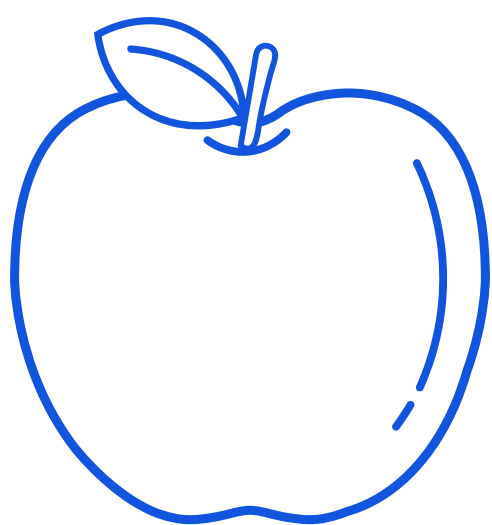


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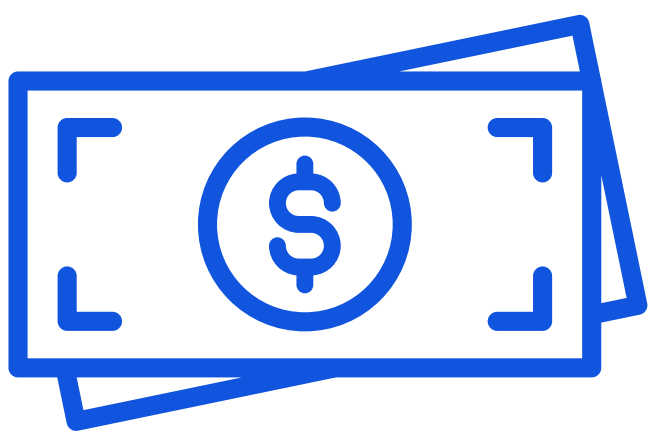
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
